Install, Maintain and Monitor Residential Alarm Systems**

Question 1: Can you please confirm that all procedures must be in accordance with the Portuguese Law?

Answer: *Yes, that is correct, we will follow all Portuguese laws.*

Question 2: Can you please confirm that this only applies to the new installations and that it may be in the form of a diagram?

Answer: *This only applies to new installations. The Embassy is seeking basic sketches of the alarm system layout, but the Embassy will not be providing the layout/diagram. An electronic copy of a rough sketch from the Contractor will suffice.*

Question 3: The scope of supply includes Sirens and Strobes, as the existing installation don't have Sirens and strobes we hereby question if in the new installation these items should be considered?

Answer: *The sirens and strobes may be requested during future alarm installations. We are not sure if the requested sirens/strobes would be interior or exterior, but we expect that the invoice for the requested work will only reflect the equipment installed.*

Question 4: Can you please clarify if the present contract should include KEY GUARDING for all the sites included in the contract or could there be, occasionally, the need for the contractor to have a key to access any of the sites?

Answer: *The key control language was added to the contract just in case a key was provided to the Contractor in order to perform work at the residence. We do not anticipate providing keys, but should they be issued for a limited scope, the Contractor is expected to secure and account for it.*

Question 5: In 2.1.7 and 2.2.7 indicate the Minimum and Maximum, should they be included in the Total Contract Price or will the Total Contract Price vary in accordance with the real quantities and Unit prices?

Answer: *The contract price will vary in accordance with the real quantities and unit prices. Also, the term "LT" refers to "lot", indicating that the pricing is expected to be based on the entire "lot" of alarm systems currently in place.*
